- **District 11 PICPC** on hold until position is filled (meets directly after District 11 meeting from 5-6 pm at the Alano Club)



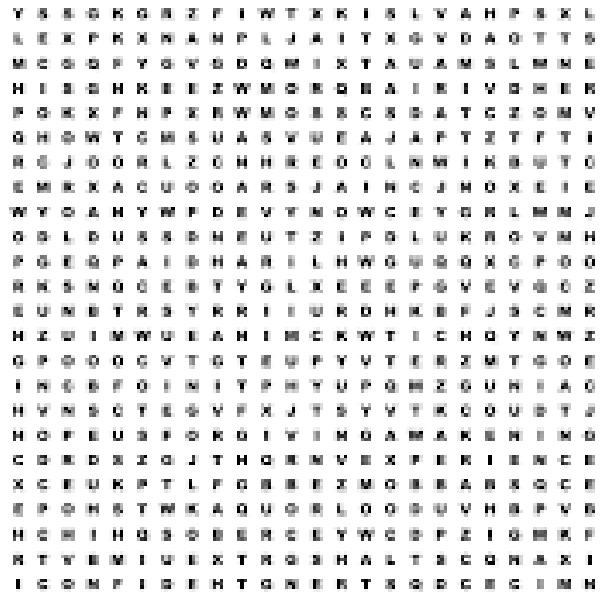
